The family coach focuses on supporting the whole family through education, skill development and connection to community resources. The Coach uses a social determinants of health (SDOH) screener at intake to identify the needs and barriers of the family.





LSS School-Centered Mental Health (SCMH) provides interventions for students, grades four through 12, who live in Milwaukee's most distressed neighborhoods. Children and their families receiving SCMH services are racial and ethnic minorities experiencing socioeconomic hardships and are English language learners. SCMH helps participants develop new skills or achieve personal goals as they learn ways to improve their well-being and everyday living. Students make strides towards recovery (i.e. improved behavior and decreased anxiety and depression). SCMH also connects families to resources to help improve financial, housing, and food security.
