

HOMME YOUTH AND FAMILY PROGRAMS



Since the founding of the agency in 1882, Homme Youth and Family Programs has been committed to each child as an infinitely valuable individual. Homme provides Comprehensive, evidence-based treatment and education in a therapeutic residential setting, including:

- **Evidence-based clinical interventions** tailored to trauma, emotional regulation, and behavior change, including TF-CBT, EMDR, DBT, Motivational Interviewing, Play Therapy, and Expressive Art Therapy
- **Specialized programming** such as Aggression Replacement Training and sex-offender-specific treatment for sexually reactive behaviors
- **Family-centered care**, with on-site housing that supports family interaction and family therapy throughout placement
- **A therapeutic campus environment** with indoor and outdoor recreational opportunities across 300 acres, promoting regulation, connection, and healthy development
- **A fully accredited on-campus school**, including a robust vocational shop program (woodworking, auto mechanics, welding, CAD) and credit recovery to support academic and career pathways
- **Creative and expressive opportunities**, including a Performing Arts Workshop with two annual performances that build confidence and social skills
- **Integrated psychiatric care**, including medication management and monthly follow-up with a psychiatric provider during placement and into aftercare
- **Real-world skill-building**, with structured community service and job opportunities to support transition and independence
